Dear Parents/Guardians

Year 12 Agreement

Following the success of leave privileges for Year 11, we wish to extend the agreement for the three terms of 2019. Students may leave school when they have no timetabled lessons, as well as leaving early or arriving late. Students will have this privilege once this form has been returned, signed by parents/guardian and student.

Students are reminded that this agreement could be withdrawn or modified at short notice if serious problems are encountered.

It is expected that each member of Year 12, as a senior HSC student, will maintain a standard of work and responsibility which will contribute to their own development as a person and provide a positive example to others. In particular, each Year 12 student has the following responsibilities.

Responsibilities

1. To observe Covenant Christian School rules, guidelines and procedures
2. To satisfactorily complete all set homework and Assessment Tasks
3. To apply themselves with diligence and sustained effort to all set tasks and experiences provided by Covenant Christian School
4. To dress in correct school uniform at all times
5. To comply with all administrative requirements.

Note: This program can only operate when the student returns the signed agreement.

The following conditions will apply to Leave Privilege:

- a) Both student and parent/guardian must sign the statements at the end of this letter.
- b) **Students must attend devotions and all timetabled lessons each day and as required for a specific purpose by any member of staff. Any student arriving late after being out without reasonable excuse will lose this privilege. Students who are late for devotions or their first lesson must obtain a late note as usual.**
- c) While off the school premises students must be correctly dressed in school uniform and must behave in a manner which brings credit on themselves and the school, reflecting its Christian character.
- d) Students must not smoke or drink alcoholic drinks.
- e) Students driving motor vehicles must drive in an exemplary fashion and with special care for passengers and other road users.

- f) Students who are passengers in other students' cars must act responsibly and with due regard for the safety of others.
- g) Students must not encourage those not in Year 12 to leave the school grounds or allow such students to accompany them off the school grounds.
- h) Students must not buy food for other students, except other Year 12 students, and bring it back to school.
- i) Students must sign out electronically at the office whenever they leave the school and must sign in again if they return on the same day.

Students who do not make use of this leave privilege will continue to be subject to the present arrangements. That is, students may use the Library and Senior Pavilion whilst not rostered on class.

The statements appearing at the end of this letter must be completed and returned to the School Office before this privilege can be granted.
