Year 11 Drama - Elements of Production

In this unit, students learn about rehearsal scheduling, the discipline of performance and the use of technical terminology in the theatre. They learn about the elements of production, such as set, properties, costume, sound and lighting, the roles of stage management and crew, front-of-house organisation and publicity, and how to work together to produce a performance.

On **Tuesday 13 August**, you are invited to watch your child perform in 'Murder By Cliché', written by Heather Pitt. There will be two performances, one at 3.15pm and one at 6.30pm.
